



## SENO'Ō GIRŌ AND MEMBERS OF THE YOUTH LEAGUE FOR REVITALIZING BUDDHISM

In this photo, we see core members of the Shinkō Bukkyō Seinen Dōmei 新興仏教青年同盟 (Youth League for Revitalizing Buddhism) in front of the Shinkō Bussei Honbu 新興仏青本部 (Revitalized Buddhist Youth Headquarters) and dormitory in Tokyo in the early summer of 1933. In the front row, seated from left to right are: Yamamoto Shōjun 山本照順 (later, Mibu Shōjun 壬生照順; 1908–1987), Seno'ō Girō 妹尾義郎 (1889–1961), and Iwamoto Nobuo 岩本信雄 (1912–1973); and in the back row, standing from left to right are: Wadō Takashi 和道隆 (d.u.), Aoki Sōei 青木宗英 (d.u.), Hayashi Reihō 林靈法 (1906–2000), and Shiga Shizumaru 志賀静丸 (d.u.). The photograph appears as the frontispiece of volume four of Seno'ō's diaries entitled *Seno'ō Girō nikki* 妹尾義郎日記, which were edited by Seno'ō Tetsutarō 妹尾鉄太郎 and Inagaki Masami 稲垣真美. They were published in seven volumes by Kokusho Kankōkai 国書刊行会 (Tokyo) in 1974–75.
