



HAKUIN VISITING HAKUYŪSHI

by *Tomioka Tessai* (1836–1924) [detail]

The inscription reads:

Zen master Hakuin visits Hakuyū at his stone cave in Shirakawa village, Yamashiro province. The details are given in Hakuin's *Idle Talk on a Night Boat (Yasenkanna)*. Some time back, I got together with some like-minded friends of mine and erected a stone tablet to indicate the site where this meeting took place.

Painted in May, Taishō 9 (1920) Tessai Gaishi, eighty five years old.
