

# Monumenta Nipponica

So far this year MN readers have learned about the systems of afforestation in the Edo period, the MOA Museum, the poet Issa's account of his father's last illness and death, Dr Willis and Sir Harry Parkes, early Japanese-Australian relations, a new Shinto sect, the development of the Ashio copper mine, and the 13th-century work of literary criticism Mumyōzōshi.

Naddition, more than thirty recent books on different aspects of Japanese culture have been assessed in detailed reviews written by an international panel of specialists.

ATER this year subscribers will read about the use of parody in *kyōgen*, the *danka* system of temples, recent excavations of the ancient temple Yamadadera, the introduction of singing into Japanese schools, further translated installments of *Mumyōzōshi*, and the debate on plant gender.
