



## **GILT-BRONZE RING STAFF**

A ceremonial sistrum or ring staff (shakujō in Japanese) thought to have been brought from China to Japan by Kūkai (774-835), the founder of the Shingon sect. This staff, a registered National Treasure, is in the possession of Zentsū-ji Temple, Kagawa prefecture. 13.8 × 27.0 cm.
